Inclusivity and Collaboration

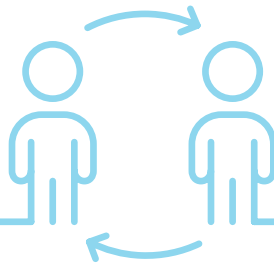
AMIA is committed to encouraging and enabling collaborations across all dimensions and all perspectives of its members and the profession.

Be the Community

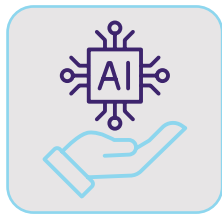
Serve as a thriving professional home for informatics professionals that provides support through every career stage.

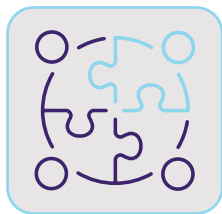
Artificial Intelligence Leadership
